

Mentorship

Mentoring programme is conducted to help the students to strengthen their varied capabilities and to build an interpersonal relationship between the teachers and students. Each teacher in all departments is assigned with the task of mentoring 25 students. This programme is conducted at two levels; group and personal. The personal level interviews with the students are also conducted periodically. “mentors assessment of students” which records a report of mentoring done by the teachers. These reports are periodically evaluated by a team of teachers selected from each department. The mentoring programme is monitored by a committee consisting of the Principal, a band of experienced faculty and a counselor.
